Executive Director's Updates

Dear ASC Members.

Happy holidays to you and your family.

We have been successful in getting an additional \$700 wage increase for most ASC members for the 2023-2024 school year. The increase is retroactive going back to July 1, 2023. You will see the first increase in your check on December 8, 2023. The retroactive pay going back to July 1, 2023, should appear on your December 22, 2023, check. If you did not receive the increase please contact me.

The ASC has been working with Board Members and the Administration to implement a wage scale for ASC members. There is no reason why we do not have a wage scale and we will be fighting to get one implemented as soon as possible.

If you are thinking of retirement, it is never too early to find out the projected numbers. In order to get your projected WRS and potential **MPS** retirement numbers you should contact Employee Trust Funds (ETF) / Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS) to obtain a formal Retirement of Benefits and Estimate Application. ETF can be reached at 877-533-5020. Also, please contact Terese Osman in the HR Department of MPS. her number is 414-475-8036. She can let you know of any additional retirement benefits you may be entitled to through MPS. Please contact me to set up an appointment to discuss the information.

There has been an increase in the number of bullying and harassment claims filed against our members. If you receive notice that a complaint has been filed against you, please call me immediately.

A major focus for the ASC has been to have a stronger voice and have a greater impact on the rules and policies that are implemented by MPS. In that vein, I am now serving on the **MPS** Strategic **Planning** Committee, the Long Range **Facility** Master Plan, the Retirement Plan Committee, the Safety Committee, and the MPS Calendar Committee.
